

SCHOOL BOARD TOWN HALL MEETING  
FEBRUARY 12, 2007

The Plano Board of Trustees met Tuesday, February 12, 2007, with the following members present: Duncan Webb, presiding; Missy Bender; Lloyd Jenkins; Mary Beth King; Brad Shanklin; Melody Timinsky; John Muns; and Superintendent Doug Otto.

President Webb called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. in the cafeteria at Plano Senior High School, 2200 Independence Parkway, Plano, and stated that the meeting has been duly called and notices posted in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code Chapter 551. Mr. Webb announced that the Board will convene in a closed session to consider 1) the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of a public officer or employee; 2) Personnel: Resignations, employment, evaluation, appointment, assignment, termination, non-renewal, additions and extension and/or renewal of contracts of individual teachers, individual administrators, superintendent, and individual support staff; 3) Private consultation with attorney regarding contemplated litigation; or on a matter in which the duty of the attorney to the governmental body under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas clearly conflicts with Chapter 551; 4) To discuss purchase, exchange, lease, sale, or value of real property; 5) School children; School district employees; disciplinary matter or complaint; and 6) Deliberation regarding economic development negotiations. The closed session was adjourned at 6:45 p.m.

The regular meeting was reconvened in the Lecture Hall, Building B at Plano Senior High School with all board members present.

President Webb called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and stated that the purpose of the meeting was to provide residents of the school district with the opportunity to share opinions and ideas regarding issues of concern regarding the school district. Approximately 15 citizens attended this meeting.

Mark Hinshaw, security police services director, presented a program on the district's safety and security programs.

Following the presentation, board members dispersed into separate areas and asked citizens to join them in order to provide an opportunity for informal interaction.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:30 pm.
