Special Academic Programs

 - continue work on methods to improve communication with the public
- Capacity Development
 - continue to explore a variety of methods to provide high quality professional development

Health Education Advisory Council

- Continue to examine and refine district practices to bring them better in line with intent of nutrition guidelines
- Examine physical education staffing ratios to ensure adequacy and safety
- Explore implications of adding summer and intramural programs before adding these to any campuses

- Develop promotional ideas that will engage the interest of students, teachers, parents and the community and facilitate their use of the vast array of electronic resources available through the library
- Promote and facilitate integration of information literacy skills throughout the curriculum and library programs in order to more effectively impact student achievement.
