

The prohibition on student possession of weapons at school or any school-related activity [see FNCG (Legal)] extends to the following items, also considered to be weapons:

1. fireworks of any kind, smoke or stink bombs, or any other pyrotechnic devices;
2. a razor, box cutter, chain, or any other object used in a way that threatens or inflicts bodily injury to another person;
3. a facsimile weapon which includes any toy, replica, collectable, or any other device or item that in size, shape, color, or design appears to be a weapon;
4. an air gun, paintball gun, or bb gun;
5. ammunition;
6. a stun gun;
7. mace or pepper spray;
8. knives of any size, including pocket knives;
9. a laser pointer for other than approved use; or
10. any articles not generally considered to be weapons, including school supplies, when the principal or designee determines that a danger exists.

The list above includes items not included in FNCG (Legal) that are specifically prohibited.

Lockers and cars parked on school premises may be inspected by school personnel if there is reasonable cause to believe they contain

weapons. [See FNF (Legal) and (Local)]

VIOLATIONS Students found to be in violation of this policy shall be subject to disciplinary action as specified in the code of conduct.
