GENERAL
PROVISIONS

All high school students shall be eligible to take courses through the District eSchool to earn credit toward graduation. Prior to enrollment in such courses, students shall make a written request to the principal or designee for approval to enroll in the course. Students shall not be awarded credit toward graduation if approval was not granted prior to enrollment.

The eSchool courses shall be supervised by the campus lead counselor. Students may earn a maximum of two credits through eSchool courses and may be enrolled in two eSchool courses at a time. **Students currently enrolled in Plano ISD may earn a total of two credits through correspondence and/or off-campus online instruction. Credits earned through campus-based online instruction are exempt from the two credit limit.** Grades earned in eSchool courses shall not be used in computing class rankings.

GRADUATING
SENIORS

Seniors who are enrolled in eSchool courses to earn units required for graduation shall complete the course and submit the grade for recording at least 30 days prior to the graduation date in order to be eligible for graduation at the end of the term.

HARDSHIP
CASES

Except for the prohibition on using eSchool grades in computing class rank, the Superintendent or designee may exercise discretion in approving eSchool course credit or waiving provisions stated above for hardship cases on an individual basis.
