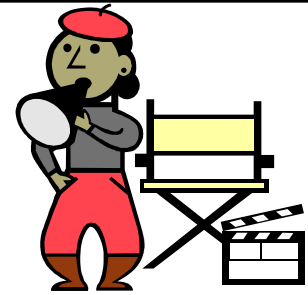


# Parental Authority: One Bite at a Time
