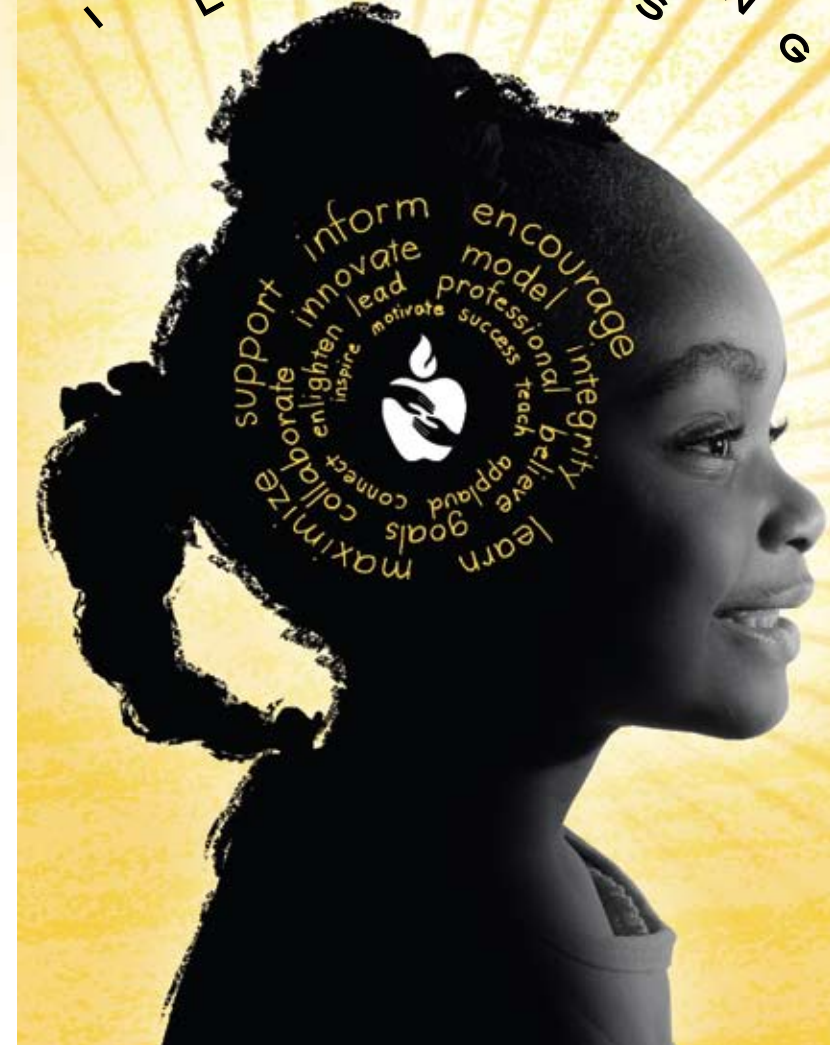

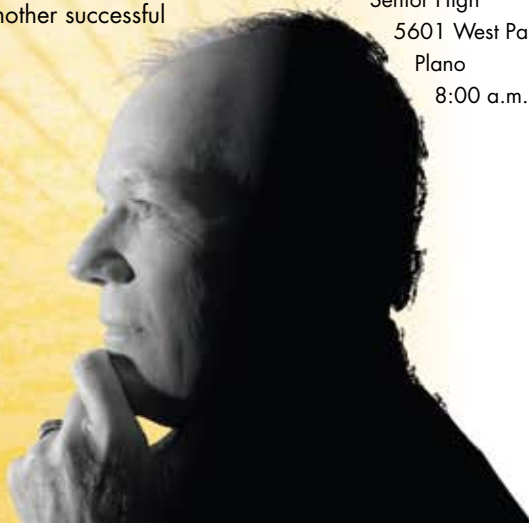
On behalf of the board of trustees and district administration, we look forward to greeting you at Convocation to kick off another successful school year.

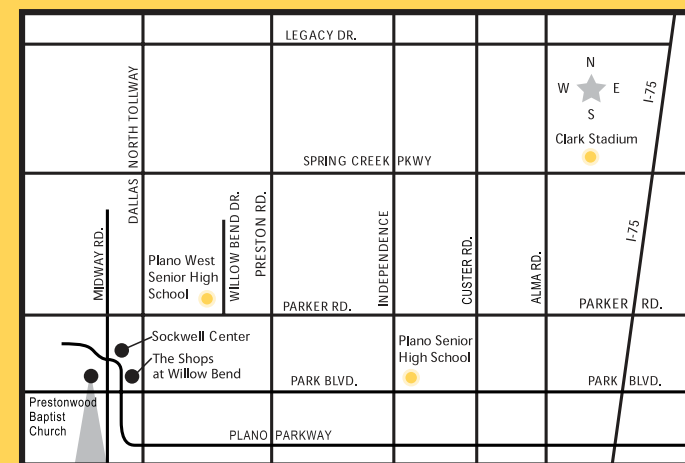

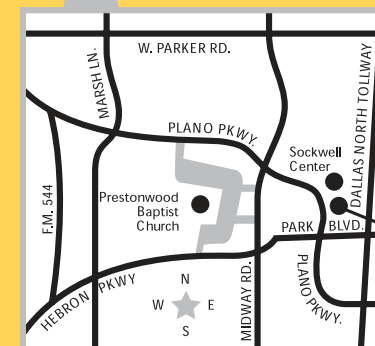
