Win National Championship
@ National Honor Society Scholars' Bowl

Congratulations to Plano Senior High School - this year's winner of the Pearson Prentice Hall National Scholars' Bowl competition. Each of the five competing Plano Senior High School students will receive a \$250 cash prize and Plano Senior High School will receive \$100.

Plano Senior High School's competing students were PSHS's NHS officers:

- Kailing Cai (scored the highest nationally during qualifications in science, \$100),
- Louisa Xu, team captain (scored third highest nationally in the math competition, \$50),
- Grace Yao (earned the second highest score nationally in English, \$75),
- David Gonzalez, and
- Evan Wise.

The annual competition, held in conjunction with the National Convention of the National Honor and National Junior Honor Societies of America, was held in Orlando, Florida on November 3-5.

The national competition tests students' knowledge of science, math, English and social studies, beginning with a set of rigorous qualifying exams, followed by rounds in which qualifying student teams compete against one another. The first round of competition is followed by a set of semifinal rounds from which the winning teams go head to head in the final competition, staged before a live audience comprised of students and educators attending the NHS competition.
