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## **Plano ISD to Dedicate Isaacs Early Childhood School on November 10**

The Plano Independent School District invites the community to attend the Dedication Ceremony for the Sara Isaacs Early Childhood School at 6:50 p.m. on Tuesday, November 10. The preschool for three- and four-year old children is located at 3400 E. Parker Road in Plano.

Dr. Doug Otto, superintendent of schools, will serve as master of ceremonies. Featured speaker will be school namesake Sara Isaacs, a retired Plano ISD administrator whose lengthy career was dedicated to the education of the district's youngest learners.

Other speakers will include Lloyd "Skip" Jenkins, president of the School Board, Mike Collinsworth, area assistant superintendent for the east cluster, Dr. Elaine Schmidt, principal, and Jane Cina, Barron Early Childhood School Teacher of the Year. Several video presentations will spotlight Isaacs students.

Staff members will translate the program for the Spanish speakers in the audience. Guests may park at Dooley Elementary School, 2425 San Gabriel Drive, and ride the Plano ISD shuttle buses to the Isaacs campus.
