Grading Policy (per 9 weeks): **60% Major Grades, 40% Minor Grades**

Quiz Grade Improvement: Any student that wishes to improve a quiz score must attend weekly tutorials scheduled by the teacher in order to receive reteach opportunities, and concept practice. The student will be reevaluated for concept mastery through the unit test. The test score (if higher than the quiz grade) will replace the previous quiz grade. This process must take place for each quiz the student would like to improve within a unit before the summative assessment (Unit Test).

If the chapter/unit test is lower or the same as the previous quiz grade the student may complete test corrections for half credit up to a 70%. The corrected test score will also replace the previous quiz grade.

Test Corrections: Any student that scores below a 70% on the chapter/unit test, may complete test corrections for half credit up to a 70%. Test corrections must be completed within 1 week from when the original test was passed back. The student must attend one mandatory tutorial session before completing corrections, but may not occur in the same session as the corrections. Full work/explanation and correct answer must be shown in order to receive credit.

Office Hours (Remote Learning)/ Tutorials: Office hours will be available daily from 7:45- 8:15 and 3:30-4:00 during this time of remote learning. Once face-to-face learning resumes, tutorials will be available during these times. Tutorials during remote learning will be scheduled during asynchronous learning times.

Absences: Students who have been absent are responsible for checking Google Classroom to get their missing assignments and any class updates. Students need to complete and submit make-up work in a timely manner. Make-up tests and quizzes must be scheduled with your teacher as soon as possible.
