



What is Dual Enrollment?

Courses give you an opportunity to earn college credit at your high school.





Benefits of Being a Collin College Dual Enrollment Student

- Small class sizes
- Educational support from Collin College instructors
- Begin a college transcript

Dual Enrollment Courses are Transferable to Most <u>Public</u> Four-Year Colleges and Universities in Texas.


Students are responsible for determining if transfer institution will accept their credits



Get to know your course syllabus and instructor





- Similar to HIPAA law
- Federal law that ensures privacy of student educational records

(begins when student starts college regardless of age)

- Collin College cannot share grades, course schedules, test scores, etc. with parents
- A great opportunity for students to learn the college process and take on new responsibilities





Dual Enrollment Eligibility

- Learners complete the <u>entire</u> Collin College admissions process
- Available with permission from your high school each semester for every course
- Must meet college readiness standards as defined by Texas Success Initiative (TSI)
- Learners must meet both high school and Collin College academic requirements to continue in the dual enrollment program

- Transferable to most public four year colleges/universities in Texas
 - Please check with private and out-of-state institutions

*Courses requiring a minimum AP score or previous college credit prior to registration



Dual Enrollment Process

- Meet with your high school counselor, if you have questions
- 2) APPLY for admission (apply.collin.edu)
- 3) Remove all holds
- 4) Register for your classes
- 5) Pay for your classes





1. Start with your high school counselor



Approval from Lead Counselor

- Mrs. Conner must approve ALL classes.
- You must have written approval from Mrs. Conner to make changes to dual enrollment classes.
- Mrs. Conner may change student schedules as necessary to meet Collin's requirements and ensure student success.





2. Application for Admission

You may apply online **NOW** for Spring 2021!

Your application must be PROCESSED before your next steps



Application Tips

- Create an account (please do NOT use your ISD email)
- List your SSN
- Under "Intended Academic Goal", select "YES" for Dual Credit
- Select any Major**
- Residency/tuition is decided based on your answers on the application and the documentation you provide, if requested
- Student will receive his/her Collin ID number (CWID), email address, CougarWeb username and password in 3-5 business days

What is CougarWeb?



Learners will receive a CougarWeb login 3-5 business days **AFTER** applications are submitted.

- Each admissions step is listed as a hold, so all steps must be completed prior to registration.
- A hold prevents registration.

Texas Success Initiative (TSI)



- The TSI is designed to measure college readiness in <u>reading</u>, <u>writing</u>, and mathematics.
- It is used for course placement purposes.
- Learners must be at college level in reading and writing for the majority of courses.



TSI: What Will I Need to Do?

- Complete Pre-Assessment Activity (PAA) and print the certificate of completion.
- Review email from regarding testing procedures.
- Pay at the cashier's office or online. The cost is \$29.
- Walk-in to test at any campus Testing Center during testing hours.
 Bring your receipt, your photo ID, and PAA certificate of completion.
 You will not need to bring a calculator.
- See an Academic Advisor to review your results.



Bacterial Meningitis Vaccination

MUST provide proof of vaccination within 5 years or documentation of an exemption if they are under the age of 22. The vaccination must be administered at least 10 days prior to start of the student's entering term.

Dual Enrollment students taking classes at their high school campus are eligible for an exemption by completing and signing the HS permission form.

- Complete quiz with a 100% score and be sure to click submit at the end





For Dual Enrollment Classes at High School/College Campus

- Log into CougarWeb
- Go to Registration and Planning
- Click on Add, Drop, or Withdraw
- Enter Credit Wintermester and Spring 2021 term
- Click on Enter CRNs tab
- Enter the specific CRN for your designated course
- Click Add to Summary
- Click Submit

Tuition

(Effective Fall 2019)

\$54 per credit hour for students residing in Collin County = \$164 for a 3 credit hour course

\$100 per credit hour for students residing out-of-county = \$302 for a 3 credit hour course


Total cost per 3 credit hour course includes a \$2 per semester student records fee.
All fees are subject to change upon approval of the Collin Board of Trustees

Tuition is paid per semester. Free & Reduced Lunch students may be eligible for a tuition waiver.






