

AMS Chromebook Expectations Form

- **Privacy**-Learners have no expectation of confidentiality or privacy with respect to any usage of a Chromebook. The District may, without prior notice or consent, log, supervise, access, view, monitor, and record use of learner Chromebooks at any time for any reason related to the operation of the District. By using a Chromebook, learners agree to such access, monitoring, and recording of their use. Teachers, school administrators, and the technology department staff may use monitoring software that allows them to view the screens and activity on learner Chromebooks.
- **Chromebook pick-up**- Chromebooks are to be picked up between 8:20 - 8:28.
 - 1st period Girls Athletics will get their Chromebooks from 9:15-9:19.
 - 8th period Boys Athletics will pick up from rooms TBD
- **Chromebooks return**- Students will turn in Chromebooks at the end of their 8th period class and plug them in so they will be charged for the next day.
- **Late Students** will quietly go to 8th period class and pick-up Chromebook before going to class.
- **Students that leave and return during the day for appointments**, leave Chromebook in the front office.
- **Students that leave and do not return**, leave Chromebook in front office and office aide delivers to 8th period teacher.
- **Consequences for not bringing Chromebook to class:**
 - 1st infraction - warning
 - 2nd infraction - 30 minute detention assigned by teacher, parent contact
 - 3rd infraction - office referral, parent contact
- Any student that **damages or alters the Chromebook intentionally**, will receive a consequence according to the Student Handbook.
- Teachers will set expectations on if and when Chromebooks should be utilized in the classroom.
- **Cases** are expected to stay on Chromebooks at all times.
- Students may decorate the label that states the name and information. These labels must stay inside the case at all times for identification.
