

Application Tips

- Username/Password
 - Something easy to recall
 - Consider saving on mobile or computer if not shared device
- Email Address
 - Do not use an ISD email
 - Do update approved senders
 - Do use an account you check regularly


Admissions Application: Account Creation

 - Sent to email address used to create the account
 - Includes Username and Email used to create account
 - Use link in the email to confirm account and sign into Apply Texas






Admissions Application: 2 Steps

Step 1: Profile Pages Things to Know

- Names:
 - Use legal name
 - social security number optional, but beneficial to help connect your records
- Citizenship: includes military affiliation for US Citizens or Permanent Residents
- Texas Residency (see next slide)















Admissions Application Dual Credit Example School > Major Options


Step 2 – Admissions Application - 2 Year Questions






