

Within the requirements of the 26 credits to earn an endorsement, a student must complete one of the concentration options below to meet the public services endorsement criteria.

Career and Technical Education (CTE)

A coherent sequence of courses for four or more credits in CTE that includes

- At least two courses in the same CTE career cluster from *Table 1*, and
- At least one advanced CTE course from Table 1 (designated with A), and
- The final course from one of the CTE career clusters listed in **Table 2** Note: Select a sequence of CTE courses that total 4 or more credits and meet the criteria above. The total number of courses is not a factor.
