A

Career and Technical Education (CTE)

A coherent sequence of courses for four or more credits in CTE that includes

- At least two courses in the same CTE career cluster from **Table 1**, and
- At least one **advanced** CTE course from Table 1 (designated with **A**), and
- The final course from one of the CTE career clusters listed in **Table 2**

Note: Select a sequence of CTE courses that total 4 or more credits and meet the criteria above. The total number of courses is not a factor.
