Welcome


Welcome was provided by Rick Cinclair, Planning Task Force Community Co-Chair and Ken Helvey, Facilitator

District Facility Services Presentation

Juan Ramos, Tony Pearson and Johnny Hill provided a District Facility Services presentation to the whole group. The Facility and Infrastructure Assessment evaluates nearly 9.4 million



square feet of school facilities and scores all 72 campuses and 19 auxiliary sites.
