Zero Based Budget Approach

Department Budgets:

Continue the enhanced process – requires each department to start with \$0 and justify budget requests with detail. A thorough evaluation will be conducted on existing programs, agreements, travel, software contracts, and processes. This enhanced process will also include evaluation on funding from special program allotments.

Campus Budgets:

 Continue with allotment per student and will allocate additional allotments by state program for qualifying students (Special Education, Gifted & Talented, Compensatory Education, Career & Technology, Bilingual, Dyslexia, Early Education Allotment, College Career & Military Readiness)
