Hepatitis A	2 doses	One dose up to 4 days before, on or after the first birthday and a second dose by age 43 months; or the second dose up to 18 months after the first dose if student is older than 43 months of age.

Footnotes:

- Serologic confirmation of immunity to measles, mumps, rubella, hepatitis B, hepatitis A, or varicella; or serologic evidence of infection is acceptable in place of vaccine.
- Previous illness for varicella may be documented with a written statement from a physician, school nurse, or the child's parent or guardian containing wording such as: "This is to verify that (name of student) had varicella disease (chickenpox).

Pneumococcal Schedule:

• One dose if child is unvaccinated or partially vaccinated after the age of twenty-four months.

Completed pneumococcal series option:

- o Two doses if first dose was given from 12-23 months of age; or
- o Three doses if first dose was given from 7-11 months of age and one dose after 1st B-Day; or
- o Four doses if first dose was given from 2-6 months and one dose after 1st B-Day.

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
