### **STUDENTS**

- Come to school on time and ready to learn
- Bring materials back and forth between school and home
- Complete all assignments to the best of their ability and read daily
- Use positive language and behavior
- Ask questions

### **FAMILIES**

- Make sure your child arrives to school on time (7:30) ready to learn
- Communicate with the office and teacher each time your child is absent
- Check your child's backpack daily for notes and class work
- Help your child to complete homework and read every night
- Complete the volunteer background check every year
- Volunteer in at least one capacity within the current school year
- Ask questions we are here to help

## **TEACHERS**

- Provide a safe and positive atmosphere for learning
- Provide Social and Emotional learning support
- Provide high quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables all children to reach high levels of success
- Provide instruction in a way that will encourage and motivate students
- Provide intervention to close student learning gaps
- Hold parent teacher conferences to discuss child's progress
- Provide parents with frequent reports on child's progress via parent portal, progress reports, and other individual opportunities
- Communicate with parents via Email, Phone calls, Notes, Dojo, and Conferences


