# 79 PLANO ISD STUDENTS NAMED NATIONAL MERIT PROGRAM SEMIFINALISTS

**PLANO, TX, September 16, 2021** – A notable 79 Plano ISD seniors were named semifinalists in the 67th annual National Merit Scholarship Program. Less than one percent of U.S. high school seniors earned this prestigious distinction and now advance to compete for some 7,500 National Merit Scholarships worth nearly \$30 million.

High school juniors entered the 2022 National Merit Scholarship Program by taking the 2020 Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT®), which served as an initial screen of program entrants. The nationwide pool of semifinalists includes the highest-scoring entrants in each state. The number of semifinalists in a state is proportional to the state's percentage of the national total of graduating seniors.

From the approximately 16,000 national semifinalists, about 15,000 are expected to advance to the finalist level, which will be announced in February by the National Merit Scholarship Corporation®). To become a finalist, the semifinalist and a high school official must submit a detailed application about the student's academic record, participation in school and community activities, demonstrated leadership abilities, employment, and honors/awards received. Scholarship recipients will be announced in the spring of 2022 and are selected from the finalists.
