Student work – Work may be requested **on the student's third day of consecutive absence**. Work will not be given prior to absence or before the third day due to potential unexpected changes in teachers' instructional pacing or exact assignments.

After School When you need to change how your student is dismissed, please email Michelle Manlick, school secretary, <u>Michelle.Manlick@pisd.edu</u> and copy your child's teacher. You may also send a handwritten note, but this method is not preferred as sometimes students fail to deliver notes to a teacher. Changes other than emergencies must be made prior to 2:00 pm. We cannot guarantee the information will make it to the classroom in time for departure if accepted after 2:00 pm. Make every effort that your child knows how to get home each day **before** arrival at school.

Visitors Entry doors are kept locked for safety. All visitors and volunteers must stop at the school office. Please note that you will be asked to provide a valid, government issued photo ID when checking into the front office as a visitor or a volunteer. You will be issued a name badge to be worn at all times in the school building, including before and after school. When leaving the school, you must stop at the front office and check out.

- <u>Video/Photography</u> Any video or photos taken of students in an academic setting are considered educational records (see FERPA). Parents are not allowed to capture photographic images of students other than their own in an academic setting. Parents must have given written permission for their student's publication in district and/or campus publications.
- **Emergency INFO** It is very important that we be able to reach you in case of an emergency. For this reason, you must update/confirm emergency information in Parent Portal for each child every year. Please report changes in address or phone numbers during the year by phone 469-752-4400 or email the school secretary.
- **Forgotten Items** After 3:45, students will not be allowed to go back to grade levels for forgotten items. This measure is important in protecting the safety of unsupervised students and the security of campus property as well as students' personal belongings and confidential information. **There will be no exceptions**.
- **Birthday Treats** A treat may be sent to school for your child's birthday to be shared with their classmates. This treat will typically be eaten while students are working. This should not be considered as a party or interfere with instruction. **Please do not send decorations, balloons, or flowers.** Any such items will be kept in the office. The receiving student will be allowed to leave the classroom for viewing in the office and will take items home at the end of the school day.
