

Students are brought to the front office after dismissal is complete.

Parents will need to sign their child out and bring carpool tag or government issued ID if they are late for pick up.



Arrival (7:40-7:55 & PM 12:12 & 12:20):

- Isaacs staff will come to the student's door.
- Student has shoes on, backpack ready, and is wearing badge.
- Students will exit the vehicle independently if possible.
- Staff will hold the student's hand and escort them safely inside to staff inside.

Dismissal (3:10 until end)

- Isaacs staff will look at car tag and call for students with neighborhood, teacher name, and student name.
- Staff member will walk student to the car, holding their hand.
- Staff member will help student into the car.
- The car tag must be always visible.
- If there is no car tag, you will need to park the vehicle in the front parking lot and bring your government ID to the front office for verification – no exceptions.

- Pull forward to the first cone.
- Pull forward to fill in spaces.
- Always stay in your vehicle.

As part of Plano ISD, Isaacs ECS follow attendance guidelines put forth by the district and the state of Texas. This means that students are marked tardy if they are not inside the building at the start of school at 7:55 AM. Plan to arrive by 7:45 AM.

Late Drop off Procedures:

Late Arrivals

- Take your child to the *front door* of Isaacs (both front and back carpool)
- Ring bell
- A staff member will meet you and your student at the front door.
 - You will be given a tardy slip to fill out. Please fill out completely.
 - Place it in the basket by the front door.
 - A staff member will walk your child to their classroom.

Parent-Teacher Communication



Teachers will contact parents by August 7:

- About SeeSaw information for their specific classroom communication - each teacher has a unique code.
 - SeeSaw is an app we use to communicate with parents.
- To provide an overview of Isaacs' procedures
- Answer any questions about Isaacs and the classroom.
- Invite parents to the Back to School Event at Isaacs ECS.
 - Tuesday -7:30 AM to 8:30 AM

Download the SeeSaw APP, enter the unique classroom code, and build a partnership with the school. You will also want contact information for the teacher.

Teachers should return phone calls and emails within one school day (24 hours). Call the front office for any messages that are time sensitive (for example, changing the way your child goes home from school). No transportation changes 45 min before dismissal. 469-752-3480


Due to space limitations, we are unable to have visitors during lunch.

School Supplies/ Spirit Wear

Medication at School

- Medication can only be dropped off at school by an adult.
- Please contact the school nurse that you are bringing medication for your child.

- NEVER send medication to school with your child.



Student Illness - When to keep your child at home due to illness:

- Temperature of 100.0 degrees or more.
- Vomiting or diarrhea.
- Pain and/or swelling at angle of jaw
- Undetermined rash over any part of the body
- Undiagnosed scaly patches on the body or scalp
- Red, draining eyes
- Intense itching with signs and symptoms of secondary infection.
- Open, draining lesions
- Jaundice

A student may return to school when they are free of symptoms for 24 hours, have been satisfactorily treated, or submits a signed physician's statement that he/she is not contagious.
