

Correspondence Courses

Plano ISD students may take high school correspondence courses from TEA-approved colleges (University of Texas at Austin and Texas Tech). Credit shall be awarded for a grade of 70 or above, but no grade points shall be assigned. The grade awarded shall appear on the student's transcript.

A student may earn a maximum of **three** credits toward high school graduation through correspondence and/or off-campus online instruction through Plano ISD eSchool.

Plano ISD will **not** accept credits awarded for Credit by Exam (CBE) from any institution other than Plano ISD.

Proctoring Correspondence Course Exams

Current Jasper students may request their Jasper counselor as the proctor for a correspondence course exam once students have completed their correspondence coursework.

The exam will be scheduled at Jasper on a designated Sunday afternoon beginning at 1:45pm. On the assigned exam date, students should enter through the North entrance at Jasper and then go to the Student Center for their exam.

Jasper High School will charge a **\$25** fee to proctor each exam.
