

TEA One Pager

- Almost all accountability data for Domains 1, 2, and 3 will be computed
- Scale Scores (0-100) and A-F Ratings will not be computed

Accelerated Testers and SAT/ACT

- Students taking high school/EOC related courses in middle school
- ESSA required a Reading, Math, and Science test to be administered
 K-5, 6-8, and 9-12
- Algebra I students in Middle School has no EOC test for 9-12
- SAT or ACT is the substitute 9-12 Math test for these students
- Scores will be attributed to the 12th grade campus

State and Federal Accountability Changes

Graduation Rate Targets for Domain 3

 Old Rule: Required the graduation rates to increase 0.1% each year until 100% was reached

New Rule:

- Meet Target of 94% and Improve 0.1% over baseline OR
- Between 90-94%, an Increase of 0.1%
 OR
- Demonstrate a 10% reduction in gap from last year rate to long-term target of 94%.
- This new rule will increase Domain 3 scores for the district and the Senior Highs/Academy.
