
SCHOOL DAY BASICS- MS. MCCUTCHEN

- No after school care


7 CLASSES A DAY

- PE


 ELA/Reading - All students take an on-level 6th grade ELA/Reading class. Two period block with the same teacher.




- Social Studies

PHYSICAL EDUCATION (PE)

1 year of PE

- Athletics does not start until 7th grade
- Off Campus PE 6th graders cannot be off campus unless they are a category 3. Category 1 is also available, <u>BUT</u> it may not work with their schedule. OCPE form will be available on the PISD website.
- Uniforms can be ordered through the PTA website. They are not required but most students order them.
