Honors Criteria

Honors placement is based on 5 Criteria:

- 1. STAAR
- 2. CogAT
- 3. MAP
- 4. Teacher Recommendations
- 5. Semester averages in class (85+)
- ❖ A student must meet at least 3 out of the 5 qualifications to be placed in an honors class.
- A student may qualify for all Honors classes, but this does not mean they should take all Honors classes.
- ❖ Appeal Form/ Opt Out form has been sent home with your student.

7th Grade Math

Students currently in:

- Math 6 → Math 7
- Math 6H → Math 7H.
- Math 7H Honors Algebra I. (High School Credit)
- Math Rocks 6 → Math Rocks 7. (Honors Algebra I-High School Credit)
- CBE is available for Math 7
- CBE is <u>not available</u> for Algebra I

7th Grade Social Studies

- Texas History
- PACE Texas History
- ❖ Students who are currently enrolled in PACE do not re-test in Middle School.
- ❖ PACE is serviced through Social Studies.

7th Grade Science

- Science 7
- Science 7H

- Science 7H first semester- requires participation in Science Fair or students must do a Research Project.
- Students are only allowed to drop Honors Science during first 6 weeks.
 After that they must wait until semester.

7th Grade English

- English 7
- English 7H

7th Grade Reading Classes

- Analytical Reading (1 semester)
- 6th grade May 2014 MAP test scores below 225
- STAAR score below 1629
- Teacher recommendation
- Accelerated Reading (2 semesters).
- 6th grade May 2014 MAP test scores below 218
- STAAR score below 1520
- Teacher Recommendation
- Final placement decisions for Reading will be made in June!

7th Grade Athletics

- Rigorous physical activity aimed at preparing students for participation in high school Athletics.
- Boys Athletics is 1st period.
- Girls Athletics is 7th period.
- Boys Athletics: football, basketball and track/C.C.
- Girls Athletics: volleyball, basketball and track/C.C.

7th Grade Athletics Requirements

- All athletes need physicals.
 - Must be turned in before any athlete is allowed to play/practice their sport.
 - The physical MUST take place after athlete completes their 6th grade school year- so the summer before they start 7th grade.
 - Physical is good for 2 years.
 - Tied to UIL; students must average a 70 to participate in competitive events.

7th Grade Boys Athletics

- All fall boy enrollees are expected to play Football.
- Basketball only players will try out in mid-November and if he makes the team his schedule will be changed.
- Track/ C.C. are both afterschool and students do not need to be enrolled in Athletics or PE to participate. (Physical still needed)

7th Grade Girl Athletics

- Girls Athletics is open enrolment, but do need coaches signature on registration card.
- If enrolled in fall, must stay in class entire semester.
- They will try out for Volleyball and if they do not make the team, will participate in an Athletic Offseason.
- They can also try out for Basketball and if they don't make the team, will participate in an Athletic Offseason.
- Track/ C.C. are both afterschool and students do not need to be enrolled in Athletics or PE to participate. (Physical still needed)

OCPE

Students applying for Off-Campus Physical Education will be considered under two (2) categories.

- **CATEGORY ONE**: These programs involve a minimum of fifteen (15) hours per week of highly intense, professionally supervised training. Students qualifying at this level may be dismissed from school one period per day for such participation.
- **CATEGORY TWO**: These programs are to be of high quality, well supervised by appropriately trained instructors, and consisting of a minimum of ten (10) hours per week. Students certified to participate at this level MAY NOT be dismissed from any part of the regular school day.
