 - *Proof of Residency include a: utility, natural gas or electricity bill, original lease agreement, etc.
- 2. Submit your payment (\$101 per test) on the Total Registration website: www.totalregistration.net/AP/445565
- 3. Use the Join Code received upon submitting your payment, and join your AP Section.

Cancellation and Refund Policy

- Refunds are not available for any AP exam.
- There is a \$40 Late-Testing Fee. Late testing is permitted due to a student conflict with *prior written approval* and is an additional fee.
