Manage structured cabling projects to ensure implementation deliverables are installed according to technical specifications and designs

Interface with appropriate technology vendors and/or ISPs during product vetting, service installations, and resolution of any problems

Supports integrated ITIL processes with Incident, Change and Problem management. Ensures all changes are well communicated, coordinated, and documented

Maintains up-to-date documentation, including diagrams, on all infrastructure services and connectivity. Practices asset management and keeps updated component inventories and related documentation and technical specifications

Be customer service oriented and maintain a professional approach regarding all district matters

Perform R&D, remain knowledgeable of emerging trends in technology, and keep abreast of innovative practices. Attain and keep current, relevant technology certifications

Perform special projects, after-hours support and upgrades
