School attendance makes a major difference in a child's life.

Plano ISD welcomes your partnership as we strongly encourage all students to attend school every day on time.

Did you know?

- Regular attendance is a skill that helps children succeed in school and life.
- All students who are voluntarily registered for school are required to attend per Texas law.
- Excessive absences could cause students to fall behind academically in school.
- Tardies can also negatively impact student academic performance.
- The constant disruption of school absences can cause anxiety and depression in students.

What parents can do:

Register for Parent Portal to monitor daily attendance and grades.
Help establish evening routines that allow children to complete homework and get enough sleep.
✓ Prepare the night before by packing lunch/snacks and laying out clothes, shoes and all
accessories.
Help your children organize backpacks and place them by the door.
Set a morning alarm that allows plenty of time to get ready and arrive to school on time.
Use our Plano ISD School Calendar to schedule appointments and trips outside of the school
day or when school is not in session.
