Priority 1: 1.1

Improve, align and remove barriers for academic programs to ensure they are accessible to and differentiated for all students to achieve high levels of learning.

Goal 1: By the end of the 24-25 school year teachers will consistently use data to differentiate instruction based on student needs.

Performance Target: Reading and Language Arts: 6th grade reading 68% meets, SPed 27% meets, Econ Dis, 40% meets 7th grade reading 60% meets, special Education 28% meets, Econ Dis 55% meets 8th grade reading 70% meets, Special Education 26%, Econ Dis. 63% by 2025.

6th grade Math 51% meets The Special Education 30% Meet . Econ Dis meets 43% 7th grade math meets 28% Special Education meets 14%. Econ dis 34%. 8th grade MAth Meets 64%. The Special Ed meets 44%. The Econ Dis meets 59% by 2025.

Expected Result: We expect to see smaller gaps between the sub pops and the general body of students.
