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Priorities

Priority 1: 1.1 Improve, align and remove barriers for academic programs to ensure they are accessible to and differentiated for all students to achieve high levels of learning.

Goal 1: By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, Carpenter MS will strengthen professional learning communities (PLCs) by implementing with fidelity, the components of the collaborative team framework along with data driven systems.

Performance Target: 6-8 READING

The percent of 6th grade students that score Meets grade level or above on STAAR Reading will increase from 47% in 2022 to 51% by June 2025. The Special Education student group performance will increase from 43% in 2022 to 47% by June 2025. The Economically Disadvantaged student group performance will increase from 17% in 2022 to 21% by 2025.

The percent of 7th grade students that score Meets grade level or above on STAAR Reading will increase from 45% in 2022 to 49% by June 2025. The Special Education student group performance will increase from 35% in 2022 to 39% by June 2025. The Economically Disadvantaged student group performance will increase from 6% in 2022 to 10% by 2025.

The percent of 8th grade students that score Meets grade level or above on STAAR Reading will increase from 43% in 2022 to 47% by June 2025. The Special Education student group performance will increase from 40% in 2022 to 44% by June 2025. The Economically Disadvantaged student group performance will increase from 29% in 2022 to 33% by 2025.

6-8 MATHEMATICS

The percent of 6th grade students that score Meets grade level or above on STAAR Math will increase from 38% in 2022 to 43% by June 2024. The Special Education student group performance will increase from 36% in 2022 to 40% by June 2024. The Economically Disadvantaged student group performance will increase from 27% in 2022 to 30% by 2024.

The percent of 7th grade students that score Meets grade level or above on STAAR Math will increase from 11% in 2022 to 20% by June 2025. The Special Education student group performance will increase from 9% in 2022 to 15% by June 2025. The Economically Disadvantaged student group performance will increase from 3% in 2022 to 10% by 2025.

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Expected Result: Teacher effectiveness will improve in planning and instructional design and delivery of quality tier 1 instruction with high yield instructional strategies, so that gaps in student group population performance on MAP, STAAR, and TELPAS will decrease and overall student achievement will increase.

Summative Evaluation: Some progress made toward meeting Goal

Next Year's Recommendation: Continuing working on PLC goal and improvement to support collaboration and student success.

Performance Target: By June 2025, our school will increase the overall student attendance rate by 1% from 93.5% to 94.5%.

Expected Result: Carpenter MS will develop systems and effective absentee strategies in order to respond to chronic absenteeism that will lead to an increase in school-wide student attendance.

Next Year's Recommendation: Continue working to improve attendance
