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Priorities

Priority 1: Strategic Plan Objective 1.2- Develop and deliver systems for learning that articulate expectations and provide support for all staff, campus administrators and district office leaders to ensure engaging, high levels of learning for all students.

Goal 1: By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, teachers will improve Tier 1 instruction by incorporating high-yield instructional strategies and techniques to accelerate student learning through the utilization of district-approved curriculum and consistent opportunities for students to practice writing with a focus on students in Quintiles 3, 4 and 5.

Performance Target: 3-5 Reading Language Arts HB#3 - The percent of 3rd-grade students that score Meets grade level or above on STAAR Reading will increase from 74% in 2022 to 76% by June 2025. The Special Education student group performance will increase from 62% in 2022 to 72% by June 2025. The Economically Disadvantaged student group performance will increase from 65% in 2022 to 71% by 2025. The percent of 4th-grade students that score Meets grade level or above on STAAR Reading will increase from 68% in 2022 to 70% by June 2025. The Special Education student group performance will increase from 33% in 2022 to 43% by June 2025. The Economically Disadvantaged student group performance will increase from 47% in 2022 to 53% by 2025. The percent of 5th-grade students that score Meets grade level or above on STAAR Reading will increase from 65% in 2022 to 67% by June 2025. The Special Education student group performance will increase from 30% in 2022 to 40% by June 2025. The Economically Disadvantaged student group performance will increase from 54% in 2022 to 60% by 2025.

3-5 Mathematics HB3 - The percent of 3rd-grade students that score Meets grade level or above on STAAR Math will increase from 62% in 2022 to 67% by June 2025. The Special Education student group performance will increase from 62% in 2022 to 72% by June 2025. The Economically Disadvantaged student group performance will increase from 45% in 2022 to 54% by 2025. The percent of 4th-grade students that score Meets grade level or above on STAAR Math will increase from 55% in 2022 to 60% by June 2025. The Special Education student group performance will increase from 22% in 2022 to 32% by June 2025. The Economically Disadvantaged student group performance will increase from 42% in 2022 to 51% by 2025. The percent of 5th-grade students that score Meets grade level or above on STAAR Math will increase from 54% in 2022 to 59% by June 2025. The Special Education student group performance will increase from 20% in 2022 to 30% by June 2025. The Economically Disadvantaged student group performance will increase from 38% in 2022 to 47% by 2025.

Students receiving accelerated instruction will average the 50th percentile in MAP growth.

Expected Result: Students receiving accelerated instruction in Quintiles 3, 4 and 5 to meet or exceed the MAP testing projected growth report by the end of the year resulting in a 2% increase in the number of students scoring at Meet grades level on Reading, Math and Science STAAR.

Goal 2: Hedgcoxe Elementary will use the PISD instructional cycle of success and strengthen professional learning communities through strategic, data driven practices and systems with a focus on Quintiles 1 & 2 students in Reading and Math.

Performance Target: 3-5 Reading Language Arts HB#3 - The percent of 3rd-grade students that score Meets grade level or above on STAAR Reading will increase from 74% in 2022 to 76% by June 2025. The Special Education student group performance will increase from 62% in 2022 to 72% by June 2025. The Economically Disadvantaged student group performance will increase from 65% in 2022 to 71% by 2025. The percent of 4th-grade students that score Meets grade level or above on STAAR Reading will increase from 68% in 2022 to 70% by June 2025. The Special Education student group performance will increase from 33% in 2022 to 43% by June 2025. 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Quintile 1 & 2 students receiving enrichment instruction will meet or pass the 50th percentile in MAP Growth.

Expected Result: Quintile 1 & 2 students receiving enrichment will meet or exceed the MAP testing projected growth report by the end of the year in Reading and Math.

Priority 2: Strategic Plan Objective 4.4- Engage the community through timely, consistent and innovative communication.

Goal 1: The all student groups attendance rates will increase through increased academic performance and community communication.

Performance Target: Better academic performance and increased student attendance. Engaged parents and community members are more likely to support students' learning at home and in the community, contributing to improved academic performance and overall student success. Strong community ties and effective communication can help address issues such as absenteeism by keeping families informed about the importance of regular attendance and providing support. The campus attendance rate will increase to 96% compared to the previous year.

Expected Result: The campus students attendance rate will increase by 0.5% making the overall attendance rate 96% or higher.
