Goal 1: By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, Murphy MS will consistently implement an effective Multi-Tiered Systems of Support process to identify students in need of Tier II/III support for academics, behavior, and/or attendance so that each student will maximize their annual growth as determined through MAP and STAAR testing.

Performance Target: Achievement Status & Growth Report - Percent of Projected Growth Met for each grade will be at least 100%.
