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# Priorities

**Priority 1:** 1.2 Strategic Plan - Develop and deliver systems for learning that articulate expectations and provide support for all staff, campus administrators and district office leaders to ensure engaging, high levels of learning for all students.

**Goal 1:** By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, Pearson will implement, with fidelity, a system to increase student performance in the area of Phonological Awareness.

**Performance Target:** 70% of students will obtain a cut score of at least 21, meeting the Approaching Standard measure for English PA on Wave 3 of the CIRCLE assessment.

80% of students who started and ended the year at Pearson will master PK4.III.C.3 Guideline utilizing the Quick Check Common Formative Assessment.

**Expected Result:** Students will be Kindergarten ready.

**Goal 2:** By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, Pearson will implement, with fidelity, a system to increase student performance in the area of Math.

**Performance Target:** 80% of students will obtain a cut score of at least 22, meeting the Approaching Standard measure for Math on Wave 3 of the CIRCLE assessment.

80% of students who started and ended the year at Pearson will master PK4.V.A.1 Guideline utilizing the Quick Check Common Formative Assessment.

**Expected Result:** Students will be Kindergarten ready.

**Priority 2:** 4.2 Strategic Plan - Implement interventions and systems of support to ensure a safe, orderly and respectful learning environment.

**Goal 1:** By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, Pearson will implement interventions and systems to support student behaviors and limit incidents of physical aggression.

**Performance Target:** 85% of students will obtain a cut score of at least 43, meeting the on-track Social Emotional Learning measure on Wave 3 of the CIRCLE assessment.

80% of students who started and ended the year at Pearson will master PK4.1.B.1.A Guideline - Child follows classroom routines utilizing the Quick Check Common Formative Assessment.

75% of students who start and end the year at Pearson will master PK4.1.B.1.C. Guideline - Child regulates own behavior utilizing the Quick Check Common Formative Assessment.
