

Can You Find?



Show your child a book and ask them to find the following things. Make it a game. Your child will have fun; however, you will be practicing important skills your child needs before he can read.

Can you find the front of the book?

(Hand the book to a child backwards, upside down, and backwards and upside down to see if she or he can still find the front.)

Where do I start?

(Open to any page and ask the child if he or she can find where you should start reading.)

Where is a word?

(Ask the child to put "a frame" around a word. Use two fingers to enclose a word.)

• Where is a letter?

(Same as above, but then identify the letter.)

How many words?

(Find a page with a few words and ask the student to count with you how many words are on the page. Help them to see the spaces between the words.)
