

IMPORTANT CHANGES TO ADVANCED PLACEMENT EXAM PROCEDURES FOR 2020-21

The College Board administers the AP program and has developed new policies that took effect with the 2019-20 school year. Plano ISD is required to honor College Board requirements in order to participate in the AP program.

- ❖ While Academy High School does not offer AP courses, PAHS students may register to take an AP exam on our campus.
- ❖ Students must create an account on the College Board website by October 20 to enter identification information required for ordering an exam.
- ❖ Students wanting to take an AP exam must register and pay in full for related 2021 AP exams no later than FRIDAY, OCTOBER 23, 2020.
- ❖ Academy High School students who want to take an AP exam will take that exam at Academy High School and are not eligible to test on another campus.
- ❖ Fees for 2021 AP exams will be \$95 per exam. A reduced fee of \$10 per exam will be available for students enrolled in the free and reduced lunch program.
- ❖ Students that cancel an exam after the posted deadlines or are absent for an exam will receive a refund for all but \$40 of the original fee.
